Sessions are suitable for different groups to equip, inspire and empower our soldiers and officers into a life of transformation both personally and as division.

CUSTOMIZED PACKAGE OPTIONS

* **One day option A**

explored throughout the day. A Spanish track for soldiers is also available when needed.

* **One day option B**

explored throughout the day with two tracks (soldiers/officers).

* **Two-day option** separating sessions for soldiers on day 1, and sessions for officers on day 2 on the topics selected.

Regardless of topics selected, all participants will be introduced to spiritual disciplines as it relates to holy living.

HOLINESS THEMES AVAILABLE

- **Principles of Holiness**

This topic explores some of the theological and historical foundations of our TSA doctrine of holiness.

- **Holiness in scripture**

This topic will consider the scripture references of the Holy Spirit as our helper to live holy lives.

- **Holiness in everyday living**

This topic provides the basis for acknowledging and cultivating God's presence in our day to day lives, exploring the vertical (personal) and horizontal (social) dimensions of holiness.

- **Holiness and spiritual formation: spiritual disciplines**

This topic provides the ABCs of deepening our spiritual life through the practice of spiritual disciplines and spiritual direction as ways to prayerfully notice God's presence and activity in our lives, how to discern God's voice and listen to the Spirit's revelation. Several methods will be explored for participants' application.

- **Holiness in community**

This topic will explore the relational nature of Holiness in a way that encourages the body of Christ to build communities with God's Kingdom mindset.

Discussion will include the peculiarities diversity pose in the cultivation of the Christian community today and our personal role in it.

SESSIONS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

(COMING SOON)

- **Seedlings-Spiritual principles for Jr. soldiers ***

This session will teach children ages 7-12 spiritual disciplines in an interactive way for a lifetime of soul health. The disciplines covered will be meditation, prayer, fasting, confession, study (Bible reading), service/stewardship, & worship.

- **Holy Shields for youth ***

This session is suitable for teens/corps cadets. Teaching will provide practical spiritual tools to daily guard their hearts and minds from secular worldviews & practices while deepening their faith and godly thinking.

SESSIONS FOR OFFICERS

- **My personal holiness**

Officers will be refreshed and inspired as they consider the benefits and responsibilities of cultivating personal holiness as ministers. Teaching will also explore the impact caring for their personal holiness will have in their family life, daily service to others & officership.

- **Fueling the holy fire**

A pastoral conversation on principles for keeping the fire of ministry burning, 2 Timothy 1:6.

- **Holiness teaching for today**

A guest speaker will provide in depth teaching on a holiness related topic as agreed by the division and SLDH department.
